ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Adarsha College of Education, Plot No-143, Vill/Tehsil/Taluka-Kadambagachi, Town/City-Barasat, P.O- Kadambagachi, Dist-North 24 Parganas, West Bengal-700124 had submitted an application (**Code No.ERCAPP1164**) to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for conducting **B.Ed Course** with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) by online on (mm/dd/yyyy) 9/29/2011 and hard copy of application submitted on (mm/dd/yyyy) 9/30/2011.

2. WHEREAS, as per the decision of ERC in its 154 meeting held on 22-23 April 2013, recognition order was issued to **Adarsha College of Education, Plot No-143, Vill/Tehsil/Taluka-Kadambagachi, Town/City-Barasat, P.O- Kadambagachi, Dist-North 24 Parganas, West Bengal-700124** for conducting **B.Ed. Course of Secondary** (level) of **one year** duration with an annual intake of **100 (one hundred)** from the academic session **2014-2015** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009, vide ERC order No. ERC/7-154.6.29/NCTE/B.Ed./2013/18195 dated 14-May-13.

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution/trust/society filed a writ petition (C) No. 345/13 in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India against the said recognition order dated 14-May-13 issued by ERC, NCTE and the Hon'ble Supreme Court disposed of the writ petition with a direction that recognition granted by the NCTE to the institution will apply for the academic session 2013-2014.

4. AND WHEREAS the Eastern Regional Committee in its 158 Meeting held on 23-24 July 2013 considered the original file of the institution along with the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 26-Jun-13 and decided that revised recognition order from the session 2013-2014 may be issued to the institution instead of the session 2014-2015.

5. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Adarsha College of Education, Plot No-143, Vill/Tehsil/Taluka-Kadambagachi, Town/City-Barasat, P.O- Kadambagachi, Dist-North 24 Parganas, West Bengal-700124** for conducting **B.Ed. Course of Secondary** (level) of **one year** duration with an annual intake of **100 (one hundred)** from the academic session **2013-2014** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

6. The recognition is subject to fulfillment of the following:
- (i) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - (ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
 - (iii) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
 - (iv) All such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
 - (v) The institution shall submit the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 - (vi) The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - a. Copy of the Application Form
 - b. Land and Building Particulars
 - c. Staff Profile
 - d. Recognition letter
 - e. Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
