**Order**

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Institute of Education, Haldia, ICARE Complex, Hatiberia, Purba Medinipur, West Bengal had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of one year duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 120 (one hundred and twenty) students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the inputs received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:


- i. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- ii. The institution will function from a rented building.
- iii. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5.00 lakhs.
- iv. The institution has selected the Principal and 07 (seven) teachers for the said course and the list of faculty members has also been approved by the affiliating University i.e. Registrar, Vidyasagar University, Vidyasagar, Midnapore.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Institute of Education, Haldia, ICARE Complex, Hatiberia, Purba Medinipur, West Bengal-721607** for **B.Ed.** Course of one year duration from the academic session **2005-2006** with an annual intake of **100 (one hundred)** students subject to fulfillment of the following:

- a. The institution will ensure that Principal and at least 07 (seven) faculty members duly approved by the affiliating University are in position for an intake of 100 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee.
- b. The institution shall appoint teachers qualified as per NCTE norms and replace the teachers not having adequate experience required under NCTE norms and shall intimate the action taken in this regard to ERC, NCTE before commencement of the academic session.
- c. The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by State Govt./ UGC and submit copy of acquittance roll in support of payment of salary to teachers.
- d. The institution shall submit supporting documents for purchase of 12 nos. of computers for the institution.
- e. The institution shall submit the list of teaching staff in the prescribed format countersigned by the affiliating university within one month of commencement of the academic session.
- f. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
