In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Kolkata Teachers' Training College, Vill – Panpur, Po. Narayanpur, Dist. 24 Pargana (N), West Bengal-743126 had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of One year duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 250 (two hundred fifty) students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the inputs received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

The inspection of the institution for B.Ed. course was conducted on 3.1.2006. The Committee considered the visiting team report, letter dated 17.7.2006 from the institution in response to ERC letter dated 12.7.2006 along with other related documents. Further, the Committee considered the Notification on UGC Regulations dated 14.6.2006 regarding exemption of NET for candidates having Ph.D. degree for PG and UG levels of teaching and for candidates having M.Phil degree in the concerned subject for UG level teaching. The Committee further noted that the institution has submitted the affidavit by the Oath Commissioner, has launched their website and also submitted a fresh list of teaching staff in the prescribed proforma but not duly countersigned by the Registrar of affiliating university.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee decided that recognition be granted to **Kolkata Teachers' Training College, Vill – Panpur, Po. Narayanpur, Dist. 24 Pargana (N), West Bengal-743126** for **B.Ed.** Course of **One** year duration from the academic session **2006-2007** with an annual intake of **100 (one hundred)** students subject to compliance of the following conditions before the commencement of the course:

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- a) The institution will ensure that Principal and at least 07 (seven) faculty members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position for an intake of 100 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee before the commencement of the course, and information be put up in the institution website as per NCTE regulation 2005, notified in Gazette of India dated 13th January, 2006.
- b) The institution shall submit to the Eastern Regional Committee list of teaching staff duly countersigned by the competent authority of the affiliating University before the commencement of the course.
- c) The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by State Govt./ UGC.
- d) The institution shall ensure that salary to the teaching staff is paid through Account payee cheque.
- e) The institution shall ensure that lecturers not having M.Ed. should acquire M.Ed. qualification within five years.
- f) The institution shall obtain affiliation from the examining body before the commencement of the course.
- g) The institution shall maintain and update their website as per NCTE regulations.
- h) The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- i) **The institution shall not admit students before complying the above conditions.**

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
